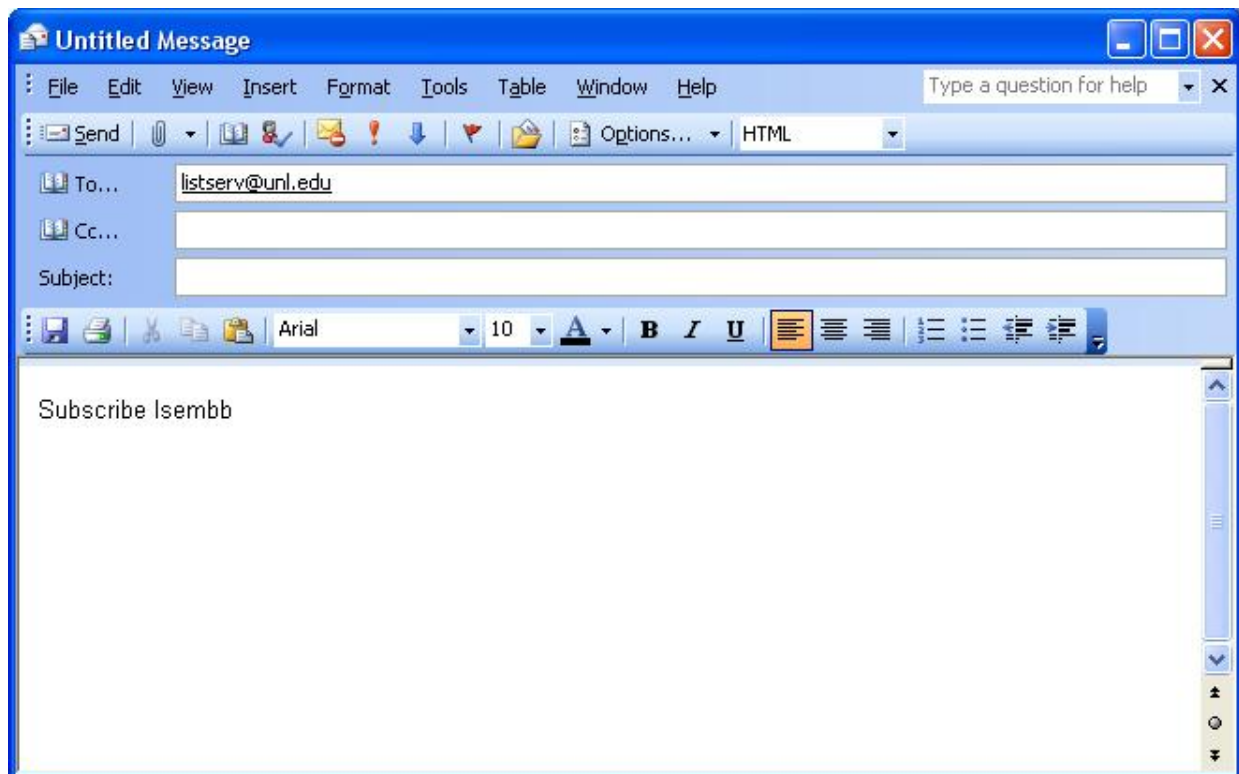


LSE Marching Band Boosters E-Mail Mailing List

In past years, we have discovered that events related to the LSE Marching Band sometimes change at the very last minute, and even with everyone's best efforts, some people are not notified of the change or issue in time (high school students are also not the best at remembering to bring printed materials home). To help "get the word out" as quickly as possible, we have setup an e-mail mailing list for the LSE Marching Band Boosters.

If you would like to subscribe to this mailing list, simply send an e-mail note to "listserv@unl.edu", and as the first line of the message, type "[subscribe lsembb](#)" (which stands for "lincoln southeast marching band boosters). The following example illustrates how the e-mail message might look:



Within a short period of time, you will receive an e-mail indicating you have been subscribed to this list. If you have difficulties with this automated process, send an e-mail to mruhrdanz@alltel.net and I can manually subscribe you to the system.

To help keep junk mail to a minimum, only messages sent by an LSE band official, or an LSE Marching Band Boosters officer, will be distributed by this system.
